SOP/Guidelines for Health and Safety protocols for Reopening of Schools and Learning with Physical/Social Distancing

The Ministry of Home Affairs has issued guidelines for the reopening of Schools following lockdown measures put in place for containment of COVID-19 in the country under the Disaster Management Act, 2005.

Accordingly, Sir Mutha School has prepared the following guidelines/SOP for the safe reopening of our school.

a) Cleaning and sanitation facilities

 Thorough cleaning and disinfecting of all areas in the school campus has been completed.

Hand washing facilities in the school.

 Foot pedal water dispensers /wall mounted Soap dispensers installed in all the washrooms.

Key supplies like thermometers , disinfectants, soaps etc. have been stocked.

b) Task Teams support assigned to various staff members

- Emergency Care Support/Hygiene Inspection/Emergency situations- Apollo Shine Clinic staff & Occupational Therapist-Mr Udaya Bharathi
- General Support Physical Education staff
- Commodity Support Store and Office Staff

c) Seating plan

- Six feet distance between each student . "One child one bench norm".
- Physical/social distancing in the Staff room, Office area and other places of public interaction.

d) Physical / social distancing at the Entry and Exit Points of the School

- Entry from Gate 3 walk through the Plasma Air curtains -pass school bags through the UV Conveyors.
- At the portico Pedal operated sanitiser dispensers to sanitize their hands before entering the main building.
- Students will exit from Gate 2.
- All students and staff to wear a face cover/mask all through the day
- Parents are requested to educate children not to exchange masks with others.

e) SOP's to be followed on the school campus.

PICK UP DROP OFF

outside the school gates.

BREAK TIME

- Social distancing will be maintained with staggered break timings for different classes.
- Children to bring their own food and water .

USE OF PLAYGROUND, LIBRARY AND LABORATORY –

- Access to playgrounds will be given only after receiving directive from the government.
- Students will attend Practical classes in the Lab in small batches.

CLEANING AND DISINFECTION OF THE PREMISES

Will be done at the beginning and end of each working day.

INFORMATION SHARING SYSTEM WITH PARENTS

class whatsapp groups and emails.

DEALING WITH EMERGENCY SITUATIONS

- If a child develops temperature or symptoms of Covid, he /she will be isolated and parents will be informed immediately.
- Disinfection of the premises will take place on the same day.

f) Display Signage and markings for enforcing physical/social distancing and safety protocols

- Signage at appropriate places in the school has been displayed.
- Marking circles at the Reception, water facility stations, hand washing stations, area outside washrooms.
- Marking separate lanes with arrows for entry and exit .

g) School events, congregations, meetings, etc.

- School will not undertake any events
- No functions and celebration of festivals.
- School assembly in their respective classrooms under the guidance of the class teacher.

h) Parent's/Guardian's consent

- Consent of parents/guardians before their child/ward begins attending school is mandatory.
- Students willing to study from home with the consent of the parents will be allowed to do so.
